Roman-Catholicks of their wives families. Others of the English and protestant inhabitants have gained the respect and esteem of the Canadians by their upright and difinterefted behaviour as Judges of the courts of Justice, Juffices of the peace, and Lawyers of ability and integrity. 'Thus Mr. Martehl by his upright and impartial conduct formerly as a Justice of the peace at Quebeck, and of late years as a Judge of the court of commonpleas at Montreal, (but more efpecially in the former character of a Justice of the peace) has gained the respect and confidence of the Canadians to an high degree. And the fame may be faid of Mr. du Calvet, a French protestant of confiderable fortune and an unfpotted reputation at Montreal, who has acted with great integrity and difinterestedness as a Justice of the peace in that place; and of Mr. Du Mas Saint Martin, another French protestant, that was a Justice of the peace at Montreal; and of Captain Gugy, an officer on half-pay, who is retired to the country and lives at Maschiche, 18 miles to the South of Three-rivers, upon part of the feigniory which he bought, and has cultivated and improved with great industry and fuccess, and who has executed the office of a Justice of the peace to the great advantage and fatisfaction of his neighbours; and of Mr. Thomas Walker, of Montreal, while he was in the commission of the peace for that district; the
