thority to hear and determine, in a fummary way, all pleas of debt, account, contracts respecting personal property, and all trespasses committed against the person or goods and chattels in the island of Newfoundland, and islands and parts adjacent, or on the banks of the said island of Newfoundland; which court shall consist of a chief judge, to be appointed by his Majesty, and two affessors, to be appointed by the governor of the faid island, from time to time; which chief judge, together with any one of fuch affesfors, shall have full power and authority to hear and determine all pleas by this act cognizable by the faid court of civil jurisdiction; and shall have fuch clerks, and other ministerial officers, as the chief judge shall think proper to appoint; and that fuch falaries shall be paid to the chief judge aforesaid, as his Majesty, his heirs and successors, shall approve and direct; and fuch falaries be paid to the affessors, and to the clerks, and ministerial officers aforesaid, as shall be approved by the faid chief judge, with the consent of the governor of the island of Newfoundland; which feveral falaries shall respectively be in lieu of all other profits and emoluments whatever; and fuch court shall be a court of record, and shall have all fuch powers as by the law of England are incident and belonging to a court of record; any thing in the faid first-men-[G 3]
