This house of education, founded in 1848, is placed under the patronage of his Lordship the Bishop of Montreal and the Seminary of St. Sulpice.

It is protected by the Provincial Government.

Its classes are opened on the 1st of September and closed on the 1st of July.

English and French are taught with the same attention.

The course of studies is of seven years, and embraces articulation and lips Reading, Catechism, Grammar, History, Geography, Arithmetic, Book-keeping, Drawing, Agriculture, &c., &c.

We have offices for printers, book-binders, and shoe-makers.

Boarding and Tuition. \$100. (School year.)
