Two Locomotives Crashed Together at Guelph—Men Leaped to Safety.

GUELPH, May 10.—(Special.)—A yard engine leaving Guelph with load of hay for provincial prison farm, crashed into a way freight from Toronto on a sharp curve 100 yards east of Train-o's Cut, about 4:30 p.m. to-day. Both engines reversed their levers and with the firemen jumped.

The yard engine is badly smashed up, and the tender is lying on the embankment. The car containing the hay was completely demolished.

The cause of the accident is alleged to be a mistake by the operator at Rockwood.
