Memorial Chapel, who was within a block of the scene of the accident when the explosion occurred, had a remarkable escape. He was in a very excited state as the result of his trying experience and was suffering from a wound in the head as a result of a kick from a horse which had been knocked down by a truck.

"When I first awoke on the scene," said he, "there was a dense black smoke pouring out of the windows of the burning building. As I looked over and women were being assisted out by the firemen, and were coming down the ladders. There was a noise from the interior of the structure and a white smoke began to pour out from the people and houses, bringing death and destruction. I darted into shelter to get away from the flying debris, and the crowd stamped down the streets. Women carried babies in their arms, and many of the horses had their food bags blocked. At Greenwell-street they were kicked and run down by the others. It was awful, all about was terror. I tried to get to the unobscured horses which had fallen. I made an effort to get him on his feet, but was kicked in the back.
