4. The activities of the RCMP in the province of Quebec center around the maintaining of national security and the enforcing of all federal statutes and executive orders. The RCMP also provide investigative and protective services to other federal departments and agencies, and provide investigative assistance to other Canadian and foreign police forces upon request. The RCMP Security Service collects information touching on Canada's internal security relative to subversive activity, including espionage, as defined in section 16(3) of the Official Secrets Act. Security inquiries are also conducted on employees of the government of Canada or applicants for employment who occupy or will occupy positions requiring security clearance.
