

There was also due for Missionaries' Salaries, and expenses at the end of 1868 \$1450

There must therefore be raised at least \$6250 for general purposes in 1869, in order to enable the Society to meet the above named deficiency and to fulfil the engagements entered into for this year. It must be clearly remembered that out of the income for general purposes \$625 has been paid to make up what was wanting in the Block Sum. The year 1870 will demand a still greater sum to make up for the largely increased reduction (\$1375) by the S. P. G. in the Block Sum for that year. Under these circumstances the Executive Committee calls upon every member of the Church to make a more vigorous exertion for the next year than has ever yet been made, for this the Society of the Church in this Diocese.

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
