

It will be a matter for consideration, as regards the most suitable locality for holding these competitions. The very limited accommodation as regards range facilities at Quebec, and the preponderance of Garrison Artillery in the Maritime Provinces, would seem to indicate that the latter would be the more suitable locality; and this Committee suggests the advisability of such action being taken by the Council as may seem advisable, with a view to bringing the matter to the attention of the Military authorities.
