SUGAR COMPANIES **DENY SHORTAGE IN**

(New York Tribune, Wednesday)
Continuation of wild trading in the raw sugar market yesterday, following reports of a probable shortage in this year's crop, caused officials of leading companies to issue statements deploring the rapid advance in prices, which, in their opinion, threatens to repeat in a smaller way the 1920 boom and subsequent smash.

Excitement in the market was heightened by the reduction in the Guma-Mejer estimate of the 1923 Cuban grop from 4,193,500 tons to 3,800,000 tons. Prices leaped upward until they reached the maximum advance for one day of one cent a pound. All months were up the one-cent limit in the futures trading, much of the buying having been reported for the account of speculative interests.
