ECCLESIASTICS HAVE GRIEVANCE Catholics and Samuel Said Not to Be in Accord in Holy Land

Rome, March 7 — The Giornale D'Italia in an article asserts that Car-dinal O'Connell, Archbishop of Bos-ton, who has just returned from a trip to the Holy Land, has reported that "grave clrcumstances of injustice, with-out extenuation, have arisen under the Government of Sir Herbert Samuel in Palestine to the prejudice of Catholics." (Sir Herbert Samuel is High Com-missioner in Palestine.) The flewspaper adds that Pope Pius "is much impressed by this new proof of a state of affairs which already was well known, and concludes by saying: "Failure to settle the question of the cenaculum" (where the Last Supper was held) "has created a painful at-mosphere in the relations between the British authorities and the ecclesiastics, as that question is mutually interestas that question is mutually interest-ing to Italy and the Holy See."


