Q. 98	Where do you live?
A, 92	Thurso, Quebec.
Q. 93	What is your occupation?
A. 93	I am the "Woods Superintendent" for the Singer Manufacturing Company at Duhamel.
Q. 94	Where is that located?
A. 94	It is about 37 miles north of Thurso.
Q. 95	How do you get from Thurso to this place?
A. 95	We go there by the Singer Company's own railroad, or by the highway.
Q. 96	What kind of vehicle do you use on the company's railroad?
A. 96	On the railroad, we use a track speeder which we generally call the "Kalamazoo".
