

The Example of Many.

W. H. Moss of Russell, Ont., took Life Policy No. 675 for \$1,000, \$27 premium, \$12.44 1870.

After paying three full premiums he began sharing in the annual division of profits. His total payments have been as follows:

Premiums in full	Dividend
\$32.32	\$52.32
12 premiums, reduced by profits, averaged \$11.81, and amounted to \$142.56.	

At age of 42 his premium is only \$2.50, to be further reduced by profits.

Should Mr. Moss wish to discontinue his payments, he is guaranteed to be paid up latterly for \$460.00, or cash \$135.20 in exchange for the present policy. Should he take the latter, his annual average cost of Insurance will only be \$4.26 per year.


