[To the Associated Press.] LONDON, Jan. 5, p. m. Breakfast quiet; console 99 3/4. An explosion of the dynamite in a coal mine at Rotherham, Yorkshire, this morning, killed 8 persons. A later despatch says 99 persons. Great preparations are being made at Barcelona for the reception of King Alfonso. The city is to be illuminated and the troops reviewed. The Bank of Spain has advanced the Government treasury 40,000,000 reals. It is stated that another message from MacMahon to the National Assembly urging it to vote for the Constitutional Laws is to be sent in.

Several persons who took part in the revolt in Albania, when a number of the Montenegrins were killed, have been condemned to death by the Turkish authorities. A Paris special says that among other things King Alfonso promises his Government will be liberal, and a constitution framed after the model of England and Belgium will be proposed; the national policy will be peaceful and conservative, and will satisfy claims of Spanish bondholders, will pardon political offenders, and grant entire liberty of worship, and to Protestants the right of burial in consecrated ground.

NEW YORK, Jan. 5, p. m. Gold 119 1/4-5 a 112 3/8; exchange 86 a 90 1/2. Sixty Spanish Commissioners with Castelar as President have been appointed to attend the Centennial at Philadelphia. No outbreak has taken place at New Orleans, though considerable excitement is manifested.

THE SPANISH FLEET of three iron clads will arrive at Marseilles to day to meet Alfonso, who leaves Paris to night.

LOUISIANA—THE CIVIL RIGHTS BILL. In the United States Senate a long and bitter discussion took place on Louisiana affairs. The Civil Rights Bill has suffered a temporary defeat in the House owing to the successful filibustering of the Democrats.

A LABOR FIERCE occurred Tuesday in Orangeburg, S. C., destroying most of the business portion of the town. Loss \$200,000, with little insurance.

THE TRIAL OF BECHER, on Tilton's civil suit for damages for the alleged seduction of Mrs. Tilton, began in Brooklyn yesterday. Three jurors have been obtained at the adjournment of the court.

(Special to Daily News.) OTTAWA, Jan. 5. Hon. Mr. Wilton, Premier of British Columbia, returned to Ottawa from London on his way West last night. He is reported as to the result of his mission, but it is considered that he will require the approval of the Dominion. He has succeeded in obtaining a grant of fifty thousand pounds from the British Government in aid of a Graving Dock at Nanaimo.
