BY-LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

SECTION I .- OF THE BY-LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

- 1. The battalion, and every member thereof, is subject to the provisions of the militia law; and to the regulations and orders established and issued from time to time by, or under authority of, His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief; and it is the duty of every officer, non-commissioned officer, and private to acquaint himself with, and obey the provisions ot, the said law, and to assist in giving general effect to the same.
- 2. The battalion by-laws and regulations are adopted for the internal government and discipline of the corps; to ensure similarity and order in the organization, control and service of the respective companies of which it is, or may be, composed; to provide for the due care of its arms and equipments, for its proper financial management, for the regulation of its public ceremonials and festivities, and generally so to determine the details of its proceedings as may best secure its efficiency and harmonious working.
- 3. The battalion by-laws and regulations as now enacted, shall only be changed, altered, or amended by a clear two-thirds majority vote of the commissioned
