

“Ward number Five” shall be bounded in front by the said Ward No. 5. River; in depth and on the South-west by the limits of the Town; and on the North-east by “Ward Number Four,” as far as the Railroad, and on the North-west of the Railroad, by the boundary line 5 of the Town on the South-west of the *Petit Rang* Road.

IV. And be it enacted, That the number of Councillors of the Number of Councillors to be ten. said Town shall be ten; two Councillors being elected by each Ward.

V. And be it enacted, That the said Councillors shall be Qualification of Councillors. chosen from among the inhabitant proprietors and householders of the said Town, of the age of twenty-one years, and freeholders therein to an assessed value of one hundred pounds currency; or such persons as shall have built on a leasehold property, a dwelling house which will *bonâ fide* rent for three pounds currency 15 per annum: and that no person shall be capable of being elected to or of performing the duties of a member of the said Town Council, if he shall not at the time be a resident of the 1 Town.

VI. And be it enacted, That the persons entitled to vote at the Qualification of Municipal electors. 20 Municipal elections of the said Town, shall be the male inhabitant freeholders and householders, of the age of twenty-one years, rated upon the assessment roll of the said Town and residing therein, possessed at the time of real property in the said Town, of the yearly value of twenty shillings currency; and tenants of 25 the age of twenty-one years, who shall have resided in the said Town, and paid rent, during the six months immediately preceding the election, on a dwelling house or part of a dwelling house therein, at the rate of not less than three pounds currency *per annum*; and also, lease-holders of the age of twenty-one years, who 30 shall have built a dwelling house on such leasehold, which would *bonâ fide* rent for a sum of three pounds currency *per annum*; Provided always, that no person qualified to vote at any Municipal Election in the said Town, shall have the right of having his vote registered, unless he shall have paid his Municipal taxes due 35 before such election; and it shall be lawful for any Municipal elector of the said Town, to require the production of the receipt of the Secretary-Treasurer of the said Town, for such assessment so due as aforesaid.

VII. And be it enacted, That the Mayor and Councillors of The present Mayor and Councillors continued in office. 40 the said Town, now in Office, and who have been so since the Municipal Election held in the month of July of the present year, shall remain and are hereby continued in office during the whole period for which they have been elected, under the provisions of
