

amongst other things ordained and enacted, That all property and estate moveable and immoveable acquired by the Trustees of the Quebec Turnpike Roads should be
 5 vested in Her Majesty for the public uses of the Province, and it is desirable that the said Trustees should accordingly be authorized and enabled to acquire and assume the possession and property of the said Draw-
 10 bridge, now called Dorchester Bridge, with the Toll-House, Turnpike and other dependencies, and the ascent and approaches thereto as aforesaid; and whereas it is also expedient to extend the provisions of the
 15 said last mentioned Ordinance to the Roads hereinafter mentioned; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall be lawful for the
 20 Trustees of the Quebec Turnpike Roads to raise by way of loan for the purposes of this Act, a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand pounds, currency; to which loan, and to the debentures to be issued in con-
 25 sequence thereof, and to all other matters incident to the said loan, all the provisions of the said last mentioned Ordinance touching the loan thereby authorized, are hereby extended and shall apply; excepting always,
 30 that the rate of interest on the loan to be raised under the authority of this Act shall not in any case exceed the rate of six per centum per annum, and that no money shall be advanced out of the Provincial Funds to
 35 pay such interest: and all debentures issued under this Act shall, so far as regards the interest payable thereon, take precedence and have priority of lien on the tolls and other monies which may come into the
 40 possession and be at the disposal of the said Trustees over the interest payable on all debentures granted or to be granted by the said Trustees for any loan already authorized by law, as well as over all claims for
 45 repayment of any sums of money advanced or to be advanced to the said Trustees by the Receiver General of this Province.
