

four, seventy-five, seventy-six and seventy-seven, and the west halves of lots number seventy-eight, seventy-nine, eighty, eighty-one, eighty-two and eighty-three in the first concession of the Township of King aforesaid, to have and enjoy all the privileges and rights of residents of the former School Section and of the School Section composed of the Village of Aurora, in so far as the privileges and benefits of the public common School thereof are concerned, for a period not exceeding twelve years from the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and shall during such period be liable to the payment of all school rates and assessments in the same manner as if they were residents of the said School Section and Village, and as if their rateable property were for such purposes included within its limits. Provided always, that if, at any time, the said inhabitants, or a majority of them, shall desire to separate from the said Village for school purposes, it shall be lawful for them so to do by giving to the School Trustees of the said Village, one year's notice thereof, in writing.

Public Act. 4. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
