Dear Sir

Thank you for receipt of Return of Indian funds in the District
of Rainy River Particulars during Quarter ending Sept 30 1929

Under this return the Department of Indian Affairs is shown to
have patented to Halvor Jensen the Light House Site 27.85 acres
together with the Road allowance through the morneau claim.
Shown on their plan filed in their Survey Return as 1557.

On 24 August 1911 I received an order in Council transferring
from the Department of Indian Affairs to the Department of Marine &
Fisheries 37 acres at the north west corner of the Parkland Indian Reserve
No. 15 Rainy River District - together with an allowance for Road leading from
the dock on Rainy River to Saw land

This is the same land as is now mentioned as patented to Halvor Jensen
only that the area is reduced to conform to the block 1700 x 1600 shown on the plan.

The order in Council was passed 7 Dec 1908, Ref No. 27443.

Recorded 19th July 1909 Lib 159 Vol 279 of Reg Registrar General.

Would you kindly advise me how this order in Council affects the
present grant to Jensen, as the present return is not shown without explanation
as conflicting, I much oblige
