

provides accommodation for families and for houseworkers and is fully equipped with kitchen and cooking facilities. On the second floor are dormitories fully equipped for the reception of single immigrants who are destined to Prince Albert for general farm work.

The Hall is situated in the City of Prince Albert near the Canadian National Railways and has not yet been officially opened. It is considered that the above Building will meet the requirements of the Prince Albert District for some considerable time.

ST BRITISH IMMIGRATION.

Under the 3000 Family Scheme 215 British families or a total of 1214 souls have been settled in the Prince Albert District. Since 1926 an additional 128 British families have been brought forward under the Empire Settlement Agreement and placed as farm workers in the Prince Albert District and during the period 1926-28 inclusive 336 British single farm workers have been placed within the same area.

During the present year 1744 trainees were placed in Western Canada. Of this number 53 were placed in the Prince Albert District but six have already been returned to the Old Country. Of the total number of 3561 trainees who were brought forward this year there have so far been deported or returned to the Old Country 330 or 9.26%.

Arrangements have been made to bring forward 3000 trainees next year but greater care is to be taken in selection
