

MEMORANDUM

For Mr. Pickering:

Through the Mr. Lapointe mentioned in your memorandum, or whatever way you got it done before, pls. have Mr. Brunet informed that Govt. is a little concerned about monument to Dr. Doughty. Appropriation is for this year, and should not be carried over to another year.

I have said to Mr. Brunet that we would not be doing anything further until he came out to Canada. I am wondering whether it would be wise to keep things waiting longer. In the event of his getting better, we may be able to find something else for him - it might be very difficult to say in Parliament we had been holding this for him. Pls. do this discreetly.
