


Ottawa, May 11th, 1933.

Dear Sir:-

I beg to inform you that the Bank of Montreal, Winnipeg, has been requested to send you the sum of \$3,520.00 in currency by the first Air Mail which leaves Edmonton on the 30th instant. This amount is made up of \$500.00 for your travelling expenses; \$1,020.00 to pay labourers wages and \$2,000.00 to cover miscellaneous expenditure at your Agency during the year.

The necessary currency for the payment of Annuity in your Agency will be forwarded to you within the next few weeks. Definite advice in this connection will be sent to you when arrangements with the Bank have been made.
