Ottawa, 26th June, 1915.

Sir,

with reference to the estate of the late Joseph Logan asking for the issue of a location ticket to his widow of the 25 acres devised to her, and also with reference to the estate of the late Silas Logan.

In reply I beg to say that the question of the location ticket to the widow of Joseph Logan will be dealt with in another letter.

It is noted with respect to the estate of the late
Siles Logan that the widow, Veturah Logan, claims to be
the only one entitled to share in her son's estate. It
appears from other correspondence in this matter that
Returah Logan is the stepmother of the late Silas Logan
and if so it does not appear how she could inherit his
property. The Department desires that you obtain from
Returah Logan a declaration setting forth whether she is
the mother or only the stepmother of Silas Logan, and also
state the names of the brothers and sisters and half-brothers
and sisters of Silas Logan. When this information is received the Department will be able to dispose of this estate.
