A-212 He said: "nobody".

Q-213 Then what happened?

A-213 Then I said why should we quit talking. Then Sgt. McNab came back the second time and he says again: "there is to be no talking", so I kept quiet, and he turned away and walked away.

Q-214 Did you make any answer to him?

A-214 No, sir.

Q-215 Did he make any explanation to you?

A-215 No, sir.

Q-216 Then what happened?

A-216 He walked ahead again, and the third time it wasn't me alone either talking again, but it was me alone that was supposed to be talking. So, he came back and he says: "there is supposed to be no talking whatever", and I turned around and looked at him, and said: "what is this, Sgt. McNabb?" He says: "just shut up".
