1. In reply to your letter of December 14, 1945, it is desired to advise that the subject aircraft is equipped with two fuel tanks each containing 110 U.S. gallons.

2. It is the intention of the owner of this aircraft to register same as a Commercial one and therefore the word "Private" may be removed from the application form.

3. Canada Veneers Limited are very anxious to obtain the formal certificates of Registration and Airworthiness for this Grumman in view of the fact that a certain amount of trouble has been experienced while in the United States without these documents, although they were able to produce the letter of authority issued by this office permitting operation temporarily.
