

The Archives' treaty holdings do not include all of the items represented in Indian Treaties and Surrenders; moreover, there are some documents in RG 10, Vols. 1840 - 1853 that do not appear in Indian Treaties and Surrenders.

There is no single explanation for the gaps evident in Vols. 1840 - 1853; however, some documents may have been retained by the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND) for operational reasons.

DIAND's Treaties and Historical Research Centre has produced a series of Treaty Research Reports that not only reproduce the text of certain treaties but also contain background essays. These are available for the eleven Western Treaties and the Robinson, Williams, and Manitoulin Island Treaties.
