FRELIGHSBURG.

A village in the parish of St. Armand East, beautifully situated among the hills on a branch of Pike River. Has three churches (Episcopal, Methodist and Catholic), a graded school, tannery, grist mill, and butter factory. About two miles west of the village, on the same stream, are the saw, grist and woollen mills of Hunter Bros. & Harvey. There is a Commissioner's Court for the trial of small causes. Frelighsburg has two daily mails—one by stage from Cowansville every evening via Dunham, and one every morning from St. Armand Station via Pigeon Hill. It is also a port of entry. Population 300. Frelighsburg has been the headquarters of Mr. J. Landsberg's large mercantile business for nearly 25 years, and is also the headoffice of the Missisquoi & Rouville Mutual Fire Ins. Co.
