

‘with the Church of Scotland, the Constitution  
 ‘of the Kirk of Scotland in the Town of Saint  
 ‘Andrews is materially altered and improved;  
 ‘and in consequence it is necessary that the for-  
 ‘mer Act of Incorporation of the Minister and  
 ‘Elders of the said Kirk should be repealed;’

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Go-  
 verner, Council; and Assembly, That an Act  
 made and passed in the Seventh Year of the  
 Reign of His late Majesty King George the  
 Fourth, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Mi-  
 nister and Elders of the Kirk of Scotland in the  
 Town of Saint Andrews*, be and the same is  
 hereby repealed.

### CAP. III.

An Act to amend the Law relative to Statute Labour, so far as the  
 same relates to the Parish of Fredericton, in the County of  
 York.

Passed 7th May 1832.

‘**W**HEREAS in and by an Act passed in  
 ‘the First Year of the Reign of His present Ma-  
 ‘jesty, intituled *An Act to repeal all the Acts  
 ‘now in Force for regulating, laying out  
 ‘and repairing Highways and Roads, and for  
 ‘appointing Commissioners and Surveyors of  
 ‘Highways in the several Towns and Parishes  
 ‘in this Province, and to make more effectual  
 ‘Provision for the same*, it is required that all  
 ‘Persons liable to perform Statute Labour on  
 ‘the Highways, Roads, Streets and Bridges,  
 ‘shall work either in Person, or by able and  
 ‘sufficient Men in their Stead, such Number of  
 ‘Days as is provided in and by the said Act, or  
 ‘pay a specified Sum of Money in lieu thereof:  
 ‘And Whereas Permission to appoint Substi-  
 ‘tutes instead of Working in Person or paying a  
 ‘specified Sum in lieu thereof, has been found  
 injurious
