

#### MARKETING OF CANADIAN CATTLE

LONDON, Feb. 24-The question of providing for the landing and marketing of Canadian cattle when the new importation of animals' bill, which supercedes the long standing embargo on importations of cattle from Canada, comes into operation, arose in the House of Commons yesterday, when Minister of Agriculture, Sir Robert Sanders was asked if arrangements had been made in connection therewith.

The minister said the landing of Canadian cattle probably become possible a few weeks hence when the act was brought into operation. It was expected that Dundee and Glasgow would be ready to receive Canadian cattle when the act came into force, he said, but he was prepared to consider the matter of approving other ports for the purpose upon receipt of proposals from port authorities. The ministry of agriculture, he added, was not aware that any markets had yet been authorized by local author-

#### **CHEMISTRY DIVISION WORK**

The extent, value, and importance of the work in which the Dominion Chemist, Dr. F. T. Shutt, is engaged, are well exemplified in the interim report of the Division for the year ending March 31, 1922. From this we learn that a total of 4,122 samples were received from all parts of the country, during the year at the Dominion laboratories for free examination, including 2 160 samples from the Meat and Canned Foods division of the Health of Animals branch of the Ottawa Department of Agriculture. The results of all these examinations are given in the report, which can be obtained free of charge from the Publications branch, Ottawa.
