LARGE HERDS OF CATTLE.

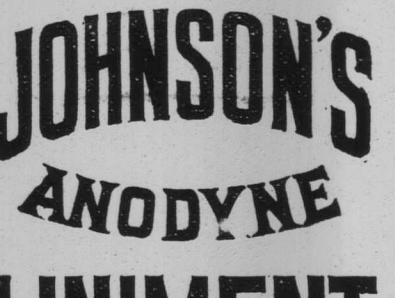
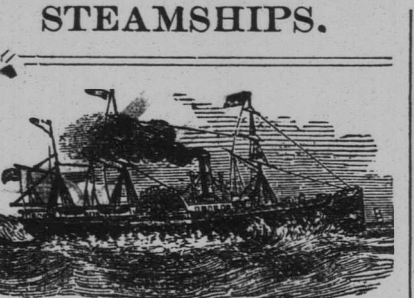
