The Century for September.

"The Century" for September has many salient points of interest. The subject which will probably attract the widest interest is the discussion of the "Treatment of Prisoners at Camp Morton," Indianapolis, during the war, a discussion begun by Dr. John A. Wyeth's article in the April "Century." The present number contains a reply to that article by Col. W. B. Holtzman, who was in the war as private secretary to Governor Morton, and the reply has the endorsement of a committee of the Grand Army of the Republic appointed to investigate the subject. The article consists largely of personal statements of officers officially connected with the Camp, systematically grouped by the writer to meet Dr. Wyeth's charges. An interesting table of "substitution stores issued to rebel prisoners at Camp Morton in 1864" is part of the article. Room is also made for a rejoinder by Dr. Wyeth, in which he quotes additional statements to substantiate his previous article.
