BECLOUDED NOTIONS OF COMMERCIAL HONOR

An apologist for Mr. Foster says he is being hit below the belt by his political opponents. Well, here is the verdict, not of a political opponent, but of a journal which is toiling daily to put Mr. Borden and Mr. Foster

"The course of the Conservative opposition at Ottawa, in relation to the insurance commission's indictment of Mr. Foster, must have received little consideration before its adoption, or else the political instinct has been completely obscured by mistaken ideas of party loyalty. The defence of Mr. Foster was too great for even a strong government to undertake. No government possessing political acumen would have attempted his defence in view of the findings and the published evidence of the insurance report. No government could afford to undertake such a defence; much less could the Conservative opposition, which has not even yet recovered from the debacle of 1806, and in which the process of coalescence is curiously slow.

"Instead of letting the affair rest with Mr. Foster's statement to the House, the opposition rushed to the rescue of the ex-finance mimster, and incidentally made a singularly bad job of it. But the task was an ungracious task, an impossible task. The vehement denunciation of the insurance commission by the same opposition which insisted upon its appointment commission by the same opposition which insisted upon its appointment is a curious illustration of how partisan struggles obscure that clear political vision and prescience which are necessary above all to an opposi-

The speeches of the opposition in the House of Commons denouncing The speeches of the opposition in the House of Commons denomicing the commission and defending Mr. Foster were singularly ineffective and unconvincing. They did not convince the House; they did not convince the Conservative party; and we are quite sure they did not convince the country. The result, however, has been to impose an added burden on the Conservative party—a burden which we believe the party will refuse to carry. It has left a too well-grounded suspicion that however censorious to carry. the opposition may be of wrong-doing or scandal on the government side, it is not only content to harbor a political Achan in its own camp, but too ready to bluster that he is without blemish. Even less than a government can an opposition afford to be lax in these things. If an opposition denounces wrong-doing amongst its opponents, and condones wrong-doing amongst its own members, the public grows more and more deaf to its arraignment or government inefficiency or dishonesty, and more and more cynical as to its sincerity and honesty and strength of purpose.

"Imagine what a commotion would have arisen had Hon. Geo, E Poster been a member of the government. Would the opposition have come to his defence, or would the opposition orators have toured the country denouncing the cynical immorality of a government which harbored a minister whose notions of commercial honer were so beclouded?

"In the last analysis it would have been sound policy and good politics

o have recognized frankl usefulness was over. It would ultimately have strengthened Mr. porden's hand, and made him free to deal ruthlessly with government wrong-doing. As it is, the opposition weakened in the country, and there are signs that his own party in Mr. Foster's present constituency will reverse the policy adopted by the opposition at Ottawa. As an instance of bad politics and a fine opportunity lost through mere perverseness and partisan blindness the ition course in this connection has been unconvincing, inapt, and disappointing."
