From Private McCormack.

The following letter was sent to Mr Michael McCormack, of Spencer St., by his son John J. McCormack, now fighting the Germans with the British Expeditionary Force in France:-

France, Aug. 10th, '15.

Dear Father,—I take pleasure in writing you these few lines to let you know that I am well, and hoping to find you the same. I have not much news to tell you, but the next time I write I hope to tell you more. I had a letter from Harry last week, it was the first one for a month. I would tell you more of the war, but we are not allowed. There was one poor fellow I knew from home, and he was killed three months ago; his name was Tucker, and he belonged to Bay Roberts, he was the only one I knew from the place. I am writing to Uncle Pat and Aunt Bridget soon. I got one from her a long time ago; and I did not get time to write. Remember me to all my friends. So good to be a so good to the pat to write. Remember me to all my friends. So good the sound in the most influential and most widely circulated newspaper in Holland, published on its first page a two column editorial virtually declaring that Chancellor von Bethmann-Hollweg's recent speech in the Reichstag was a menace to the neutral States. The article gains in significance from the fact that the Courant heretofore has been considered strongly pro-German. The paper says:

"What the German Chancellor in the Reichstag on Aug. 19 described as 'a new Europe'—under the general enthusiastic applause of his hearers—is in the eyes of us neutrals a future hell. 


