Furthermore from dried and fresh otatoes a bleaching powder can be btained that finds use in the bleachng of juices and alcoholic liquors. formerly such a bleaching powder vas made from charred bone, or wood nd blood. For the production of leaching powder the poorest, comletely rotten potatoes as well as the spoiled dry potatoes are used.
