HAY WAS EASIER ON LOCAL MARKET

Prices Ranged From \$12 to \$14 a Ton This Morning.

BERRIES 9 CENTS A BOX

Large Supply Is Expected on Thursday—Oats were lower—The Quotations.

Hay was easier on the local market this morning. Oats were lower. The price of the hay was \$12 to \$14 a ton. The majority of the loads were at \$13 a ton.

There were a few loads of straw in, but they sold slowly from \$6 to \$7 a ton. Oats—Prices were lower than yesterday, but still somewhat above the normal, owing to the fact that the dealers are anxious to get a supply. This morning's quotations were from \$12 to \$15 per cwt.

A small quantity of strawberries were offered at 9c per box retail and 8c wholesale. It is expected that there will be a fairly large supply tomorrow, but not as large as Tuesday's big day.
