REPORT OF THE ANNUAL MEETING

HELD IN THE METROPOLITAN W. M. CHURCH, TORONTO, ON WEDNESDAY  
EVENING, MAY 22ND.

The Hon. G. W. Allan, Senator, President, in the chair.\*

The beautiful and spacious edifice was filled, although the weather was most unfavourable.

The Rev. George Cochran, Pastor of the Church, opened the meeting by reading the 55th chapter of Isaiah, and with prayer.
