I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of Your Excellency's note of today's date reading as follows:

"I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between Canada and Japan for Air Services which was signed at Ottawa on January 12, 1955.

"In accordance with Article XVIII of the Agreement, I have been instructed to notify you that this Agreement has been approved by the Government of Canada and to propose that the Agreement come into force upon the date of your note indicating the approval of the Government of Japan."

I wish to notify Your Excellency that the Agreement has been approved also by the Government of Japan, and, accordingly, it comes into force as from this day.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency, Monsieur l'Ambassadeur, the assurance of my highest consideration.
