

The Second Technical Assistance Conference was convened by the Secretary-General of the United Nations in accordance with the resolution of the General Assembly of 12 January 1952, the relevant portions of which read as follows:

"THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

REQUESTS the Secretary-General

(a) Subject to the provisions of any other resolution adopted by the General Assembly, at its sixth regular session, concerning the pledging of extra-budgetary funds, to convene a conference for the purpose of ascertaining approximately the total amount of contributions for the second financial period available from the participating governments, subject to the approval of their respective legislative authorities for the execution of the technical assistance programmes of the United Nations and of the specialized agencies.

(b) To invite to the conference with the right to vote all Members of the United Nations and other States which are members of the specialized agencies participating in the programme, and likewise to invite without the right to vote representatives of the specialized agencies and of the States which are members of the United Nations and of the specialized agencies.
