- 2. The Board shall elect one member as Chairperson from among the Trustees, excluding the Director General. The term of the Chairperson shall be three years. The Board may re-elect that member as Chairperson for a second term.
- 3. The Board shall meet at least once annually. Between its meetings, the Board may take decisions by mail, electronic mail, facsimile or other means of telecommunications.
- 4. The Board shall adopt its own rules of procedure, subject to this Agreement.
- 5. A majority of Trustees shall constitute a quorum for Board meetings.

## ARTICLE 12 - Appointment of the Director General

- Subject to paragraph 3 of this Article, the appointment of the Director General and, if necessary, his or her dismissal for cause shall be decided by the Board and approved by the Council.
- 2. The Director General shall be appointed initially for a fixed term not exceeding four years. The appointment may be renewed for a second term.
- 3. The first Director General shall be appointed for a first term by the Sponsors.

## ARTICLE 13 - Functions and Powers of the Director General

- The Director General is the Chief Executive Officer of the Network and is the head of the Secretariat.
- 2. The Director General shall be responsible inter alia for:
  - ensuring that the programmé of the Network is carried out in conformity with the highest professional standards;
  - finding, in collaboration with the Council and Board, sources of revenues for the work of INBAR;
