PRAYERS

Mr. Fox for Mr. Poulin, from the Standing Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs, presented the Eleventh Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Friday, April 18, 1975, your Committee has considered Bill C-3, An Act to amend the British North America Acts, 1867 to 1965 and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

New Clause 2

Add immediately after line 21, on page 1, the following new clause:

"2. For the purposes of this Act, the term "Province" in section 23 of the *British North America Act*, 1867 has the same meaning as is assigned to the term "province" by section 28 of the *Interpretation Act*."

Renumber the present Clause 2 as Clause 3.

Clause 3

Strike out "1974" in line 23, on page 1, and substitute therefor "1975".

Strike out "1974" in line 26, on page 1, and substitute therefor "1975".

Your Committee has ordered a reprint of Bill C-3 as amended for the use of the House of Commons at the report stage.

A copy of the Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence relating to this Bill (*Issue No. 25*) is tabled.

The House resumed debate on the motion of Mr. Lang, seconded by Mr. Drury,—That Bill C-41, An Act respecting the stabilization of net proceeds from the production and sale of western grain and to amend certain statutes in consequence thereof, be now read a second time and referred to the Standing Committee on Agriculture.

And on the motion of Mr. Baker (Grenville-Carleton), seconded by Mr. McKinley,—That Bill C-41 be not now read a second time but that the subject-matter thereof be referred to the Standing Committee on Agriculture.
