Our metallurgical coal production has grown from approximately 417,000 tons in 1976 to 1.2 million tons in 1977. At the present time our production rate is running about 1.5 million

tons. In the current year production rates have continued to improve, and had it not been for a short strike and operating difficulties in the early part of 1977, the full deliveries of coal would have been supplied to our Great Lakes customers.
