

The King's Bench at Montreal, for causes of the same kind, is to be held also two terms annually, which shall be the first ten days of March and September (Sundays and holidays excepted.)

The Court of King's Bench for civil causes, is to be held, at four superior terms, in the cities of Quebec and Montreal, for each district respectively, viz. the first twenty days in the months of February, April, June and October, every year, (Sundays and holidays excepted.)

The Court of King's Bench for the district of Three Rivers, is to sit two terms annually, in the town of Three Rivers, for trial of all causes criminal and civil, viz. all the days of the months of March and September, after the thirteenth, (Sundays and holidays excepted.) The first four days of each term to be employed in trial of Criminal causes, and the rest in civil causes.

INFERIOR TERMS.

There are to be held six inferior terms, by one or more Judges of the said Court of King's Bench annually, for civil causes under 10*l.* sterling, viz. In the city of Quebec, for the District of Quebec, the remaining days of the months of January, May, August and November, after the 21st; in the month of March, from the 11th to the 19th day, and in the month of June, from the 24th, to the end of the month (Sundays and holidays excepted.)—In the city and for the District of Montreal, at the same times as mentioned above, also from the 11th to the 19th September.

PROVINCIAL COURTS.

The Provincial judge for the District of Three Rivers is to hold a Court of civil pleas, six inferior terms annually, in the town of Three Rivers, viz. the first ten days in the months of February, April, June, August, October and December (Sundays and holidays excepted.)

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
