who took poffeffion of South-America, had gold-hilts to their fwords; but unluckily they had neither a fhirt to put on their back, nor meat to put in their belly; and yet they had great plenty of money: but with all their money, were they really rich? if they were, I give them joy of their unfubftantial riches, and would rather chufe to remain in Old England, where, without a gold-hilted fword, or even without a fword at all, I can have a clean fhirt and a good dinner.

The cafe is the fame, if the commodities we want be fuch as cannot be purchafed with money. By thefe, I do not mean health, firength, beauty, fenfe, or any other qualities, whether of body or mind (if indeed thefe may be called commodities) which it is neither in our power to procure, nor in the power of any human creature to beftow; but I mean empires, kingdoms, and all independent flates of what denomination foever,
