We have been favored with a New-York paper of the 14th February, containing extracte from Glafgow papers to the 4th January. Thefeextracts represent the fituation of Great-Britain as flourishing beyond example: the 3 per Cents had rifen in confequence, to 73 3 8.1-4. The Parliament had adjourned to the 3d February.

The Report of the change in the title of the. French Conful, is given in a private letter from Paris: the Senate was fitting on tome important uffair, and the creating Bonaparte Emperor of the Gauls and Cifalpine Republic, was generally believed would be the refuit. In a conference with the Swife deputies, on the 12th Deer. Bonaparte told them that they must enter into no alliance with England; and he faid the only way for them to become truly great, would be by becoming a departments of France. It is confidentially flated, that the Floridas have also been ceded to France, in return for the Duchies of Parma and Guaftalla. Reinforcements to the amount of 20,000 men were to be fent to St. Domingo : 6. Batallions of Infantry feveral detachment of Cavalry and of Artillery were embarked at Helvotfluy's for Louisianna; and the Officers of the Civil Government were to fail at the fame time.
