Vaisseaux hors d'etat, le Florissant, 74 can. en radant Glorieux 74 can. Raisonable 64 can. sur les chautiers: Prostance, et Surprize, 30 can. a contrain.

By which it appears, there was nothing to fear from the naval power of *France* on the part of the ocean or channel; and that, notwithstanding the report of a powerful convoy to be fitted out at *Brest* and *Rochfort*, to favour an invasion, it could not be possible that they, who believed this state of the *French* marine to be true, could think it necessary to neglect every other service of their country to wait the motions of so despicable a gascoynade.

NEITHER can I think that the following advices relating to an invasion of Great Britain and Ireland, were deserving of greater attention. For, though the Earl of Holderness was informed by letters of the 2d of March, that it was said a camp would be formed for 40,000 men between Dunkirk and Boulogne; and that thirty-two transport ships were taken up at Boulogne, and fixty more were expected in March to be escorted by the Blune and Blonde frigates from Havre:
