will be more vigourous and be better prepared for the final fattening period.

Mr. Grisdale's experiment on this point is very interesting, proving that a good sufficient but limited ration, gave more vigourous hogs and producing the gain on a cheaper basis than the unlimited one.

Hogs thus prepared, are easily finished by the use of a more conentrated ration during the last period of fattening.

A certain quantity of bacon produced is soft and is a 2nd class roduct commanding a lower price. What are the causes of this oftness ?

They are no doubt numerous. Following are the principle ones:

1.-Hog being too young.

2.-Irregular-thriving and ill-health.

3.-Lack of exercice.

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
