WHEAT FUTURES RISE AGAIN

Advance at Both Chicago and Liverpool.

Cash Article Higher at Duluth and Minneapolis-Northwest Receipts Lighter-Marked Appreciation in This Month's Delivery - Local Grain, Fruit and Cattle Markets -Notes and Gossip.

On the Liverpool Board to-day wheat futures advanced 3/4, but the spot article eased off 1/4 to 1/2 cent. Paris wheat closed 20 centimes lower than yesterday, with four 10 centimes lower to 10 centimes higher. On the Chicago Board this morning wheat showed marked strength, this month's delivery advancing 15c and the December and May options 5c and 6c respectively. The selling feeling was founded on the encouraging early cables, the good seaboard clearances, and an advance in the cash article. Northwest points. Later the market eased off on lack of support and liberal primary receipts. At the close the October, December and May options reflected net gains of 1c, 3/4c and 1/2c per bushel respectively over yesterday's final figures. Chicago corn closed 1/2c per bushel higher than yesterday. Liverpool maize to-day firmed up to the extent of 1/4 to 1/2 cent. London is up 6d at Liverpool. Bacon rose 6d at Liverpool to-day. December wheat puts, 63c; wheat, 63c; corn puts, 29c; corn, 29c. Total clearances to-day: Wheat and flour equal to 550,000 bushels; corn, 374,000 bushels. Exports at New York to-day: Flour, 12,000 barrels and 45,576 sacks; wheat, 221,000 bushels. One hundred and forty loads of wheat reported taken for export at New York yesterday. Argentine shipments this week nil, against all last week and all the same week a year ago. Maize shipments 192,000 bushels, against 1,424,000 last week and none the corresponding week of 1897. Liverpool wheat receipts the past three days 277,000 cwt., including 253,000 cwt. of American. Corn, same time, 218,000 cwt. Total wheat receipts to-day, 91 cars of which 68 are contract. Receipts of wheat at Minneapolis and Duluth to-day 1019 cars, as against 1120 cars the corresponding day of last year. Car receipts of grain at Chicago to-day: Wheat 262, corn 863, oats 388.

U. S. Millers Are Busy. Modern Miller says: Southwestern mills are running full time, largely on local and domestic orders, although there has been a fair export demand, at prices which many of the mills have been able to accept. Southern mills are generally running to full capacity and keeping down surplus stocks, but complain of lagging trade. Foreign country is improving and export orders are being more freely booked, but at close prices.

Big Increase in the Visible. It is figured that Monday's statistics will show an increase of 1,500,000 bushels in the visible supply of wheat in Canada and the United States. Stocks of wheat at Minneapolis and Duluth are expected to show a decrease of 500,000 bushels for the current week.

Common peaches sold at 30c to 40c, and choice large varieties at 50c to 75c per basket; grapes, 12c to 14c for small baskets; and 20c to 25c for large; plums, 10c to 20c; apples, \$1 to \$1.50 per bushel, and 15c to 25c per basket; peaches, 30c to 40c; cucumbers, 40c to 50c for green and 20c to 30c for yellow; tomatoes, 15c to 20c per basket; muskmelons, 20c to 30c per basket; egg plant, 50c per basket; celery, 30c to 40c per dozen.

LOCAL LIVE STOCK MARKET. The run of live stock at the Cattle Market to-day was large—33 loads—composed of 1100 cattle, 1000 sheep and lambs, 2500 hogs and 50 calves. The total receipts for the two days, Thursday and Friday, amounted to 151 loads.

The cattle were composed principally of feeders and stockers, a few loads of exporters and several loads of butchers' stock. Exporters—Choice heavy export cattle sold at \$4.40 to \$4.50, with two loads of extra choice 10c more; light export cattle sold at \$4 to \$4.10 per cwt.; light exporters at \$4.20 to \$4.30 for medium export cattle.

Export Butts—Prices for export butts were \$2.20 to \$2.30 for medium export butts, choice, and \$2.25 to \$2.30 for medium export butts.
