by a Sabbath collection, \$15.00, and \$13.00 dispensed by the pastor and Mr. Hiram Robinson, Elder,—leaving \$4.57 on hand.

The Sabbath School and Bible Class have been regularly conducted during the year, and with hopeful results.

The financial condition of the congregation will be laid before you in the Report of the Temporal Committee, and to it we earnestly ask your attention, and bespeak your most hearty coöperation in carrying out to a succetsful issue the scheme which has been inaugurated to reduce the indebtedness of the Congregation. We trust that in relation to this effort, as well as with regard to every other duty, the earnest question of each one of us may be "Lord, what wilt Thou have me to do," and, following in the footsteps of our Divine Saviour, let us "Work the works of Him that sent us while it is day, for the night cometh when no man can work." And now, in conclusion, our prayer for each of you is—" The Lord bless thee and keep thee: the Lord make His face shine upon Thee and be gracious unto thee: the Lord lift up His countenance upon thee and give thee peace."
