

**Novelty Champion
Wins \$10,000 H'c'p
Cup for Countless**

SARATOGA, Aug. 27.—Novelty, admirably ridden by Shilling and carrying top weight, 135 pounds, won the Rensselaer Handicap, worth \$10,000, six furlongs, here to-day, defeating the best youngsters in training. By this victory to-day he is

training. By this victory to-day he is stamped as the champion 2-year-old of the year. Novelty was quoted at 4 to 1 in the betting and won by a neck from Naushon, with Textile third. Courtless proved a big surprise when he easily defeated Ciambala, the 2 to 9 favorite, in the Saratoga Cup. Courtless led from start to finish and won by four lengths.
