SENATOR STANFIELD

IS MAN OF ACTION

New Appointee a Success in Business as Well as Politics.

Colonel, the Hon. John Stanfield, ex-M.P., who has been appointed senator of Nova Scotia, was born in Charlottetown, P.E.I., in 1863 (the anniversary of Canada's first birthday).

Returning to Truro later on, he, in partnership with his brother, bought out their father's small woollen mill. In 1896 Stanfield's mill employed 17. The turn-over was approximately \$2,000. Each succeeding year has shown a substantial increase, in fact for 35 years Stanfield's have not had an unprofitable year.

For 25 years John Stanfield has been president of Stanfield's, and its continued success is due in a large measure to his ability. During this period the mills have not had a serious accident or fire, neither has there been a strike, which is in part explained by the fact that during all this time there has been no general reduction in wages.

Prominent in Politics. In 1907 Stanfield was asked to contest the by-election in the interests of the Conservative party. It looked like a hopeless task as the Liberals had a solid 18 from Nova Scotia, and the all Liberal government was practically certain to be re-elected.

At the general elections in 1908 he was elected, and was made chief whip of the Conservative party at Ottawa. Again, in September, 1911, he was elected, and at the same time the Laurier government was defeated. He then became chief government whip, and no reins than honest John Stanfield in 1916 he was offered a senatorship, but he refused. Later in the year, when in England, he was offered the high position of governor of Nova Scotia.

Early in 1916 he resigned his position as chief whip, as the war was then in progress, and he decided his duty was to go overseas to France and Italy, with his usual push and energy he raised the money to do this. He then went to the front, and was in a few weeks, against his wishes and advice, he returned to his military duties and in due course went to England.

John Stanfield's appointment to the senate by Premier Meighen is one of the most popular made for many a long day. The new senator is in his 57th year and is at present organizing the first battalion of the Canadian Trench and Hants Regiment, of which he is colonel. He has two sons, John and Harold.
