Your Secretary has also received from Miss Wilson, Secretary of the International Council, copies of the Constitution and Bylaws of the International Council; Minutes of the meeting; a Report of the progress of the International Council during the last four years; a paper by Miss Wilson on "National Councils of Women;" and a circular letter from Her Excellency, the President of the International Council; and the matter contained therein will be brought before you to-morrow morning.

Fraternal greetings have been received from the National Council of Women of Great Britain, formerly known as the National Union of Women Workers, through their Secretary, Miss Janes, who also sent a copy of the Verbatim Report of their last Conference and a request for copies of our publications. It has been decided by the Executive Committee that a file of the Verbatim Reports of this Council, bound, be sent to the British Council in return.

Fraternal greetings have also been received from the National Council of Women in our sister colony of New Zealand, accompanied by a copy of their Constitutions and By-laws, and a printed abstract of their last annual meeting, which was held last year in the Provincial Council Chamber in Christ Church. The National Councils in Germany, Sweden and other countries have been holding Council Meetings, and we hope to have in time a complete file

The matter of the adoption of a Universal Peace Flag by the nations of the world is being urged by the Universal Peace Bureau of Berne, and at the request of the Countess di Brazza, acting for the Bureau of Berne, the subject was considered by a Special Committee, whose report in the form of a resolution has been placed upon the Agenda for your consideration.

Your officers having all been renominated unanimously by the Local Councils and Nationally Organized Societies no ballot for election will be necessary.
